

Department of Kinesiology

Department of Kinesiology at Keimyung University began in 1984 as the first physical education program in the Daegu. Throughout its long history, department of kinesiology has been producing competent professionals and athletes in the fields of physical education, health promotion, and elite athletics, establishing itself as a center for physical education and sports talent in Korea. In the 21st century, the concept of quality of life is gaining attention, and there is a growing interest in health promotion through physical activity around the world. In order to respond to these rapidly changing social demands and needs, the physical education major is constantly striving to cultivate physical education talents essential for the future society through a specialized curriculum aimed at fostering professional physical educators who are competitive in the global era. In particular, the department has a curriculum that meets global standards based on faculty members with international expertise, a sports science laboratory equipped with advanced experimental equipment, and industry-academia cooperation with various fields including sports, and aims to foster competitive and creative physical education professionals who will lead the 21st century.

Academic Information

Course Credit

- ▶ A course credit is set according to each course. There is a grade system in place for students. Failed courses are not counted as credits.

0 credit	The Chapel and Thesis courses need to be passed (even though they are zero credit) in order to graduate
1 credit	1-hour class instruction a week or each 2-hour laboratory class/experiment class/practice class a week during a semester
2 credit	2-hour class instruction a week or each 4-hour laboratory class/experiment class/practice class a week during a semester.
3 credit	3-hour class instruction a week or a 6-hour laboratory class/experiment class/practice class a practice class a week during a semester.

Course Registration

- ▶ Students have full responsibility to select and register for courses.
- ▶ Students can register for at maximum of 20 credits a semester, and the number of credit cannot exceed more than 36 in a year.(Until students entering in 2023). Students can register for at maximum of 18 credits a semester, and the number of credit cannot exceed more than 34 in a year.(From students entering in 2024).
- ▶ Students who have GPA over 4.25 for the previous semester can register for additional 3 credits in the following semester.

Graduation Thesis

- ▶ The Graduation thesis, which is a required course, is required to be completed as a “Pass” credit. If students do not meet the submission deadline, graduation can be deferred.
- ▶ However, foreign students majoring in physical education can substitute the graduation thesis when obtaining TOPIK level 3.

Attendance

1. Electronic Attendance System

- ▶ Automatic attendance processing system using mobile (app) and Bluetooth

2. Acknowledgment of Attendance

- ▶ Absence due to death of relatives
 - Parents, spouses, children: 7days
 - Brothers, grandparents and maternal grandparents: 3days
 - Relatives within the fourth cousins: 1 day
- ▶ Participation in special events such as government or public institutions and participation in official school events is limited to the period approved by the Director of the School's Welfare Service
- ▶ Study visits and excursions of the department (major) and college (undergraduate) are limited to the period approved by the dean.
- ▶ Your marriage: 7 days
- ▶ Inpatient treatment: up to 2 weeks (no absence due to outpatient treatment)
- ▶ Students who have been approved by the President for reasons other than.

3. Submission of Documents

- ▶ Apply through the EDWARD system with supporting documents within 14 days before and after the reason for absence occurs.

1. Assessment of Grades

- ▶ Scores are comprehensively evaluated by our professors who are in charge of the attendance records, assignments, and presentations of the courses.

2) Grades and GPA Calculation

- ▶ $(\text{Course grades} \times \text{credits}) \text{ total} / \text{total credits of Course Registration}$. However, waived credits are excluded in calculating GPA.

Graduation

1. Graduation Thesis

- The Graduation thesis, which is a required course, is required to be completed as a "Pass" credit. If students do not meet the submission deadline, graduation can be deferred. (Refer to the below procedure and deadline)
- ▶ Requirements for Substitute Graduation Thesis for Physical Education Major
 - students who meet at least one of the following requirements may substitute the graduation thesis.

- Acquisition of certificates issued by the Korea Sports Association and Professional Sports Association.
- National technical qualifications such as computer-related qualifications
- Foreign students majoring in physical education can substitute graduation thesis when obtaining TOPIK level 3 or higher.

2. Early Graduation

- ▶ Early graduation is the system that gives permission for high-performing to graduate early with a shortening of the learning period.
- ▶ Qualification
 - Students, who completed 4 years' worth of courses and have completed over 6 semesters with an overall GPA of 4.25(including waived completed credits) and over 130 credits. The final semester's grades should be included. However, students who received an "F" credit cannot apply for the early graduation.

3. Graduation Extension

- ▶ Students should apply for graduation extension in the EDWARD System, and receive approval of it.
- ▶ For students' tuition that got approval for the graduation delay, follow the Credit Registration Rule.
- ▶ Graduation Extension is limited to two times.

International Student Scholarship

Admission Scholarship

- ▶ Type C: TOPIK level 3: 50% Waiver of Tuition Fee
- ▶ Type B: TOPIK level 4: 70% Waiver of Tuition Fee
- ▶ Type A: TOPIK level 5 or higher: 100% Waiver of Tuition Fee

Student Achievement Scholarship

- ▶ Jinri (100% Waiver of Tuition Fee for the next semester)
 - Enrolled student whose GPA for the previous semester is more than 4.2 (A minimum of 15 credits with no failed courses)
- ▶ Jeongui (50% Waiver of Tuition Fee for the next semester)
 - Enrolled student whose GPA for the previous semester is more than 3.0 (A minimum of 15 credits with no failed courses)
- ▶ Sarang (30% Waiver of Tuition Fee for the next semester)
 - Enrolled student whose GPA for the previous semester is more than 2.0 (A minimum of 3 credits)

Campus Life

Student ID Number

- ▶ The Student ID number is an important information. All students will be given their own student ID number. Be sure to remember the information because it will be frequently required during your university life.
- ▶ Available at iMBank after the 2nd of March
- ▶ Photo(Identification photo, 3cm x 4cm) and identification card
- ▶ The Student ID card is received within about 1 month applying.
- ▶ Students should sign for the agreement to provide personal information via EDWARD System in advance. (EDWARD System > Academics > Student Support > Student ID Card Request)
*Student ID cards are available as debit card and library cards.
- ▶ How to apply when Students lost their ID cards
 - Apply via the EDWARD System(EDWARD System > Academics > Student Support > Student ID Card Re-issuance Request>Student ID Loss/Cancel>Add button and visit iMBank(or apply via Internet)

EDWARD System

- ▶ Keimyung Website Quick Link → EDWARD System
- ▶ Course registration, confirmation of course registration, permanent grade queries, the syllabus, etc., are all available through the EDWARD System. If there is some important information for the students, the university contacts the students by letter or SMS. If there is a change in your basic information, address, cell phone number, please revise via the system promptly.

Input Student Record

- ▶ (EDWARD System > System > Common Services > My Account Settings)
 - Be sure to input your contact information on the personal information section of the EDWARD System. Students should pay attention and avoid being criticized for any mistakes in not inputting the below information correctly.
 - 1) Student Information: Graduation date and name of elementary, middle, and high schools.
 - 2) Family Relations: Reference data for professors' student consultation
 - 3) Career Path
 - 4) Address: Sending tuition bills and several sorts of academic information for guidance
 - 5) E-mail: When there is a password loss on the EDWARD System, it will be re-sent to an e-mail address, and job market information from the Job Placement Office can also be sent this way.
 - 6) Cell Phone: The cell phone is important for delivering SMS services, academic information such as acceptance number for leave of absences and return, enrollment, etc.
